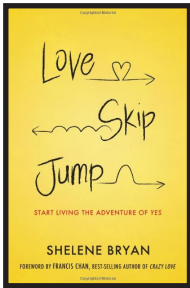


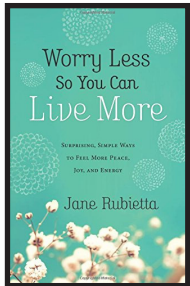

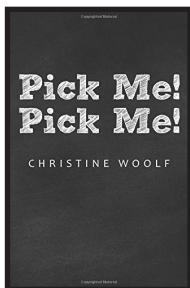

2. Worry Less So You Can Live More



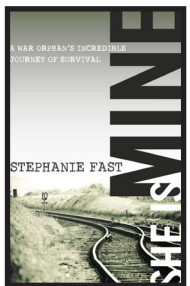
